

**IDYLLWILD ARTS ACADEMY** is located in a mountain environment, and temperatures may vary greatly daily. Our winter season includes rain, snow, and temperatures below freezing. Since storage space is limited, clothing and belongings should be selected carefully and “extras” should be kept to a minimum. Every dorm room is furnished with Twin XL beds, a built-in closet, chairs, and a desk with the dimensions 42” L x 24” W x 30” H. Storage under beds can fit a long, flat bin no higher than 12”.



## ITEMS TO BRING

- Warm gloves and hat
  - Warm jacket and boots resistant to snow and rain
  - Light jacket or sweater
  - Sweat suit
  - Tennis shoes/sneakers
  - Shorts and tee shirts
  - Swimming suit
  - Alarm clock
  - Telephone
  - Watch
  - Blankets or quilts (2)
  - Comforter
  - Bedspread
  - Sheets, twin xl size (2)
  - Pillows & pillow cases (2)
  - Towels & washcloths
  - Laundry bags
  - Hangers
  - Flashlight
  - Toilet articles
  - Laundry soap
  - One roll of quarters for operating laundry machines
  - Writing materials
  - Study or reading lamp
  - Desk supplies
  - Trunk or box in which student may lock personal possessions
  - Book bag or day pack (1 required)
  - Instruments (music students)
  - TI-83 or TI-84 calculator
  - Dictionary and Thesaurus
  - Although the Academy maintains a computer lab, students are required to bring their own computers. See Student/Parent Handbook.
    - Intel Core i5, i7 or i9 (Skylake or more recent), AMD equivalent or Apple Silicon
    - At least 16GB RAM
    - At least 256GB storage
    - 802.11n, or 802.11ac Wireless capabilities

## ITEMS NOT TO BRING

- Televisions
- Video gaming systems (such as X-Box, Playstation, etc.)
- Furniture that is too big for one person to carry
- Torch halogen lamps
- Skateboards and scooters
- Weapons of any kind
- Candles or incense
- Pets
- Cordless telephones (due to radio interference)
- WiFi access points
- Computer monitors larger than 32 inches
- Air Conditioners
- Microwaves
- Toaster ovens
- Space Heaters
- Cleaning supplies (these will be provided)
- Cooking Appliances (such as hot pots, electric griddles, and grills)
  - Due to fire safety and hygiene concerns there is no cooking allowed in dorm rooms.
  - The only appliance allowed in dorm rooms is a water kettle with an automatic shutoff.
  - Students may store cooking devices in the common room kitchenette on a limited basis.
